
## Making the Triangle Pieced Squares


- 1. On the wrong side of the (2) 3" Background squares draw a diagonal line.
- Match one Background square right sides together with each of the Star's 3" squares.
- 3. Sew 1/4" from both sides of the line. Set seams and cut apart on drawn line.
- 4. Press seams toward Star fabrics. Square up to 2½".
- 5. Lay out the Triangle Pieced squares with (4) 2½" Background squares.
- 6. Flip Background squares over Triangle Pieced squares and sew.
- 7. Set and press seams toward Background square.


### **Making the Long Star Points**

- 1. On the wrong side of (4) 2½" Background squares draw a diagonal line.
- 2. With right sides together place a 2½"

  Background square on one end of each of the 2½" x 4½" Star fabrics.











3. Sew on the drawn line. Cut off top left corner leaving a ¼" seam allowance.





4. Set seam and press toward Star fabrics.




### Finishing the Block


1. Lay out Long Star Points with Triangle Pieced Square Star Points. Pair up the different Star fabrics.







2. With right sides together sew and press toward Long Star Points.






3. Lay out pieces to complete block. Flip patch on right over patch on left. Sew.





4. Set seam and press toward the Darker Long Star Points.



5. Sew remaining seam. Set and press open.
